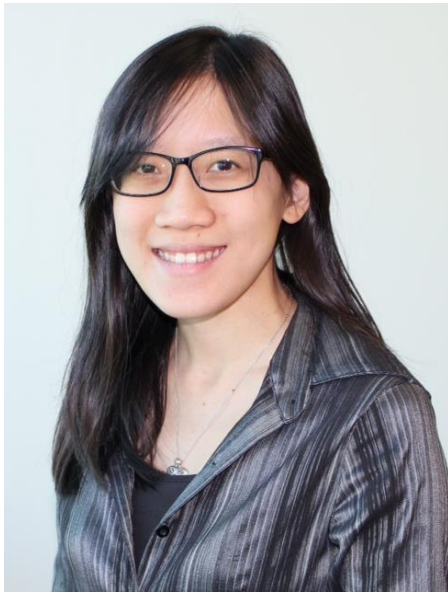


JANE LOKE



Jane Loke is the current research coordinator of Peri/Postnatal Epigenetics Twins Study (PETS), a longitudinal cohort established by Principal Investigators Prof. Jeffery Craig and Prof. Richard Saffery in Victoria, Australia. Her work with PETS started way back in 2010 where she analysed associations between shared/non-shared prenatal factors and birth epigenetics data of these twins during her PhD. In addition to her research interests on early life environmental influence on the epigenetic profile of offspring, she enjoys the management aspect of cohort studies. At present, she is following up with PETS as they turn 11 years old, coordinating collection of cognitive data, MRI scans and biological samples from these twins.
